



Covid – 19 Outbreak Management Plan

Parent Information

Autumn 2021

- **Anyone with Covid-19 Symptoms must NOT attend Pre-school, they should isolate and get a PCR test. With a negative result or 10-day isolation completed your child can return. If you have a positive case in your household your child will need a negative PCR result to continue attending Pre-school.**
- **Your child cannot come to Pre-school if they have had medication which may mask a temperature, this includes Calpol/Paracetamol. After jabs/illness they should be kept off for 48 hours until fever free.**
- **Everybody will need to clean or sanitise their hands and temperatures will be taken on entry to the building.**
- **Parents and staff are encouraged to keep 2m distance and use one way system. If you come into Pre-school for a visit, you will be asked to wear a mask and your temperature will be taken.**
- **Staff are still continuing to do Lateral Flow Test twice weekly. If the LFT result was positive then a PCR would be taken as soon as possible and as long as PCR test is negative staff can return to work.**
- **If Staff develop Covid-19 symptoms then a PCR test will be taken and follow procedures as outlined in the first point. If the majority of staff are tested positive, we will have no option but to close until end of isolation.**
- **Please send your child with layers, as we will prioritise outdoor learning and when inside we will have windows open for good ventilation.**
